What we are asking, is for an experienced assessment home, you may consider foster-to-adopt but temp foster is fine too, because we need to get a handle on what is happening with this pretty lady. She is not quite 5 years old yet and is spayed and in good health to the best of our knowledge.

However, over the past few weeks she has become less settled - is she bored? It is possible, and that is not in any way a reflection on her current home but it may be a possibility due to circumstance. Her owner is not well and not in the first flush of youth either. Is she uncomfortable somehow? Maybe, she has been vet-checked and declared to be in good health, but let's get her checked over.

Sadly, her owner is not able to keep her any longer due to these changes in her character, so we would like to find out what she needs and make sure she has that. She is still young and is fit and well, and she is sociable out and about too. She just seems to not want to share or be shared at home.

Serial fostering is something I absolutely love doing, patch 'em up and send 'em to their new homes - very rewarding! But sometimes that 'patching' is not physical, it is more about the state of mind of the dog and that is also incredibly interesting. I don't think she will present much of challenge, I have had hands-on this girl and she just seems to know her own mind, typica female Frenchie - and we need to know more about it now too. And look at her - she is VERY pretty.
